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## Importance of the Establishment of Majlis Anşārullāh

Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ II (may Allāh be pleased with him), describes the importance of establishment of Majlis Anşārullāh in the following words:

“Remember that your name is Anşārullāh, that is, the helpers of God Almighty. It means that you have been associated with the name of God Almighty, and God Almighty is everlasting and immortal so you should also try to be a manifestation of immortality. May you become the true symbol of Anşārullāh, meaning that may you always uphold the institution of Khilāfat and ensure that this work continues in your future generations as well. This can be achieved in two ways. One way is that your children are properly trained and love of Khilāfat is inculcated in them. That is why I established Majlis Aṭḥālul Ahmadiyya, and Majlis Khuddāmul Ahmadiyya was instituted for the same purpose. These Aṭḥāl and Khuddām are your own children. If Aṭḥālul Ahmadiyya are properly trained, then Khuddāmul Ahmadiyya will also be properly trained. And if Khuddāmul Ahmadiyya are properly trained, then the next generation of Anşārullāh will also be superior. I have created a hierarchy. The first stage is Aṭḥālul Ahmadiyya, the second stage is Khuddāmul Ahmadiyya, the third stage is Anşārullāh, and the fourth stage is God Almighty. If you provide proper guidance to your children as well as supplicate to God Almighty, then all these stages will be accomplished. If your Aṭḥāl and Khuddām are properly guided as well as you supplicate to God Almighty and establish relationship with Him, then there is no other place for you except heaven. And whoever is raised to heaven, he is safe in every respect. If the world tries to attack, it can only attack up to a hundred or two hundred feet at the most, but cannot reach to the heaven. Therefore, if you reform yourselves and supplicate to God Almighty, then you will establish a relationship with Him. And if you become true Anşārullāh and establish a relationship with God Almighty then the Khilāfat will remain among you forever, and it will last even longer than the Khilāfat of Christianity.”

## مجلس انصار اللہ کے قیام کی اہمیت

حضرت خلیفۃ المسیح الثانیؒ مجلس انصار اللہ کے قیام کی اہمیت مندرجہ ذیل الفاظ میں یوں بیان فرماتے ہیں:

”یاد رکھو تمہارا نام انصار اللہ ہے یعنی اللہ تعالیٰ کے مددگار۔ گویا تمہیں اللہ تعالیٰ کے نام کی طرف منسوب کیا گیا ہے اور اللہ تعالیٰ ازلی اور ابدی ہے۔ اس لئے تم کو بھی کوشش کرنی چاہئے کہ ابدیت کے مظہر ہو جاؤ۔ تم اپنے انصار ہونے کی علامت یعنی خلافت کو ہمیشہ ہمیش کے لئے قائم رکھتے چلے جاؤ اور کوشش کرو کہ یہ کام نسل بعد نسل چلتا چلا جاوے اور اس کے دوزریے ہو سکتے ہیں۔ ایک ذریعہ تو یہ ہے کہ اپنی اولاد کی صحیح تربیت کی جائے اور اس میں خلافت کی محبت قائم کی جائے۔ اسی لئے میں نے اطفال الاحمدیہ کی تنظیم قائم کی تھی اور خدام الاحمدیہ کا قیام عمل میں لایا گیا تھا۔ یہ اطفال اور خدام آپ لوگوں کے ہی بچے ہیں۔ اگر اطفال الاحمدیہ کی تربیت صحیح ہوگی تو خدام الاحمدیہ کی تربیت صحیح ہوگی اور اگر خدام الاحمدیہ کی تربیت صحیح ہوگی تو اگلی نسل انصار اللہ کی اعلیٰ ہوگی۔ میں نے سیڑھیاں بنادی ہیں۔ آگے کام کرنا تمہارا کام ہے۔ پہلی سیڑھی اطفال الاحمدیہ ہے۔ دوسری سیڑھی خدام الاحمدیہ ہے۔ تیسری سیڑھی انصار اللہ ہے اور چوتھی سیڑھی خدا تعالیٰ ہے۔ تم اپنی اولاد کی صحیح تربیت کرو اور دوسری طرف خدا تعالیٰ سے دعائیں مانگو تو یہ چاروں سیڑھیاں مکمل ہو جائیں گی۔ اگر تمہارے اطفال اور خدام ٹھیک ہو جائیں اور پھر تم بھی دعائیں کرو اور خدا تعالیٰ سے تعلق پیدا کر لو تو پھر تمہارے لئے عرش سے نیچے کوئی جگہ نہیں اور جو عرش پر چلا جائے وہ بالکل محفوظ ہو جاتا ہے۔ دنیا حملہ کرنے کی کوشش کرے تو وہ زیادہ سے زیادہ سود و سوفٹ پر حملہ کر سکتی ہے۔ وہ عرش پر حملہ نہیں کر سکتی۔ پس اگر تم اپنی اصلاح کر لو گے اور خدا تعالیٰ سے دعائیں کرو گے تو تمہارا اللہ تعالیٰ سے تعلق قائم ہو جائے گا اور اگر تم حقیقی انصار اللہ بن جاؤ اور خدا تعالیٰ سے تعلق پیدا کر لو تو تمہارے اندر خلافت بھی دائمی طور پر رہے گی اور وہ عیسائیت کی خلافت سے بھی لمبی چلے گی۔“

## Aims and Objectives of Majlis Anşārullāh

The aim of the organization is to promote the moral and spiritual training of its members resulting in a Godly, righteous, responsible and just society, true both to God and His creatures. The aims and objectives of the organization are reflected in the pledge, which every member must make and recite in every formal meeting. These aims are as follows:

1. To organize all male Ahmadi Muslims over the age of forty years in the Silsila Aliya Ahmadiyya (Ahmadiyya Muslim Community).
2. To inculcate the following amongst its members:
  - a) The love of Allāh.
  - b) The spirit to promote and propagate the teachings of Islam.
  - c) Exhort to preach Islam and serve mankind.
  - d) The spiritual and moral training of children.
  - e) The spirit of protecting the institution of Khilāfat.
  - f) The spirit of placing collective interests above individual interests.
3. To remain a purely religious organization with no political interest whatsoever.



## Majlis Anşārullāh Pledge

I shall also be prepared to offer the greatest sacrifice for this cause. Moreover, I shall urge all my children to remain true to Khilāfat Ahmadiyya. Insha-Allāh.

## Duties and Powers of Office-Bearers

Following are the Duties and Powers of Office-Bearers as specified in the Constitution of Majlis Anşārullāh Canada.

### **Sadr**

110. The Sadr shall supervise the affairs of Majlis Anşārullāh.
111. The Sadr shall be responsible to carry out successfully the programme of Majlis Anşārullāh.
112. The Sadr shall preside over the meetings of Majlis Anşārullāh Mulk. The Nā'ib Sadr shall perform this duty in his absence.
113. The Sadr is authorized to temporarily appoint someone to officiate in his place but he will have to intimate Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh and the national Amīr immediately.
114. The Sadr shall approve the appointment of all office-bearers whether through election or nomination of subordinate Majālis. In case an election or nomination is rejected the concerned Majlis or the concerned office-bearer shall hold fresh elections or suggest fresh nominations and seek the approval of Sadr Majlis.
115. Sadr Majlis has the power to reject the appointment of an office-bearer without giving any reason. Any member so rejected shall not be re-elected or re-nominated for a period of two years.
116. In special circumstances after getting permission from Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh, Sadr Majlis may suspend the rights of election or nomination of a Majlis or an office-bearer for a specific period and nominate the office-bearers himself. Similarly in special circumstances he may recommend to Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh the dissolution of a Majlis.
117. The explanation and interpretation of the rules and regulations of Majlis Anşārullāh and the Dastūr Asāsi shall rest with the Sadr Majlis and his decision in this respect shall be the final and binding.
118. The accounts of the Majlis shall be operated by Sadr or Nā'ib Sadr Awwal jointly with Qā'id Māl.
119. Sadr Majlis may prescribe reformative measures concerning a member or an office-bearer of a Majlis. It shall be obligatory for the member or members of the concerned Majlis to carry out these measures.
120. Sadr Majlis has the power to reject the majority decision of a Majlis on any matter. In case of Majlis 'Āmila Mulk he shall report the matter to Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh for final approval.





121. In case a subordinate Majlis asks Sadr Majlis for permission to make specific collections from members on a special occasion, the Sadr Majlis will request the national Amīr for opinion and then refer the matter to Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh for final approval.
122. Sadr Majlis has the power to exempt members from full or part payment of subscriptions in case of their inability to pay, provided it is recommended by the concerned office-bearer.
123. No formal appeal can be lodged against the decisions of Sadr Majlis but the matter may be reported to Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh.
124. Sadr Majlis shall send the report of his activities to Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh every month.
125. Sadr Majlis has the power to appoint some-one to officiate for any subordinate office-bearer.

### **Nā'ib Sadr Awwal (First Vice President)**

126. The powers and duties of Nā'ib Sadr Awwal shall be those delegated to him by Sadr Majlis.
127. When Sadr is on leave, Nā'ib Sadr Awwal shall act as Sadr and exercise all the powers of Sadr in his absence. Even during the presence of Sadr under his direct supervision and guidance his powers can be exercised by Nā'ib Sadr Awwal.
128. Nā'ib Sadr Awwal will not be empowered to cancel or alter the orders of the Sadr Majlis while officiating as Sadr.

### **Nā'ib Sadr Saf Dom**

129. Nā'ib Sadr Saf Dom shall organize the members of Saf Dom under the general supervision of Sadr Majlis. He shall try that all the members of Saf Dom participate in all the programmes chalked out by Majlis Ansharullāh.
130. Nā'ib Sadr Saf Dom shall see that members of Saf Dom own bicycles and promote cycling amongst them.
131. Nā'ib Sadr Saf Dom shall see that maximum number of members of Saf Dom participate in the program of cycling with the purpose of meeting the people and doing social service.
132. Nā'ib Sadr Saf Dom shall present the report of his activities to Sadr Majlis every month.

### **Nā'ib Sadrān**

133. The duties and powers of a Nā'ib Sadr shall be to the extent they are delegated to him by Sadr Majlis.



**Qā'id 'Umūmi**

134. Qā'id 'Umūmi shall be the in charge of the office at the headquarters.
135. It shall be the duty of Qā'id 'Umūmi to see that the instructions of Sadr Majlis are being carried out and remind all concerned when necessary.
136. Qā'id 'Umūmi shall maintain the record of proceedings of Majlis 'Āmila Mulk and shall also inform the members of the concerned Majālis about it.
137. Qā'id 'Umūmi shall sign all vouchers concerning expenditure of headquarters office.
138. It shall be the duty of Qā'id 'Umūmi to publicize the aims and objects of the Majlis and to organize the Majlis at as many places as possible.

**Qā'id Ta'līm**

139. It shall be the duty of Qā'id Ta'līm to propagate and inculcate the Islamic teaching amongst the members of Majlis Anşārullāh.
140. Qā'id Ta'līm shall arrange the education of illiterate persons.

**Qā'id Tarbiyat**

141. It shall be the duty of Qā'id Tarbiyat to take necessary steps for the development of true Islamic character amongst members of Majlis Anşārullāh.

**Qā'id Māl**

142. Qā'id Māl shall organize the assessment of Annual Budget of all the Majālis and shall arrange collection of subscriptions according to this budget.
143. Qā'id Māl shall operate the accounts of the Majlis jointly with the Sadr or Nā'ib Sadr Awwal.
144. Qā'id Māl shall correspond with the Majālis on matters concerning his department.
145. Qā'id Māl shall present the names of members who are defaulters in the payments of subscriptions to the Sadr and take action according to his instructions.
146. Qā'id Māl shall present the Annual Budget of Majlis Anşārullāh Mulk proposed by Majlis 'Āmila Mulk, for approval to Majlis Shūrā Anşārullāh.





147. Qā'id Māl shall present the income and expenditure statement before Majlis 'Āmila Mulk every month.

### **Qā'id Isār**

148. Qā'id Isār shall chalk out programmes in order to sympathize with Allāh's creatures, to serve them and to work for their welfare and shall ask all the Majālis to act upon these programmes.

### **Qā'id Tablīgh**

149. Qā'id Tablīgh shall prepare all members to practically participate in preaching.
150. Qā'id Tablīgh shall prepare a scheme for preaching and shall motivate the Majālis to use all their resources to implement it.

### **Qā'id Zahānat Wa Sehat Jismāni**

151. Qā'id Zahānat Wa Sehat Jismāni shall chalk out programme for maintaining intellectual and physical health of members.

### **Qā'id Waqf Jadīd**

152. Qā'id Waqf Jadīd shall motivate members of Majlis Ansharullāh to participate in the financial sacrifices and other programmes of Waqf Jadīd.

### **Qā'id Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd**

153. Qā'id Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd shall motivate members of Majlis Ansharullāh to participate in the financial sacrifices of Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd. He shall also make the demands of Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd known to all the members.

### **Qā'id Tajnīd**

154. Qā'id Tajnīd shall see that each Ahmadī who has attained the age of Ansharullāh is included in the Tajnīd (i.e. enrolment).
155. Qā'id Tajnīd shall see that complete record of enrolment is maintained and the system of Sa'iqeen (i.e. group leaders) is established in the Majālis.

### **Qā'id Ishā'at**

156. Qā'id Ishā'at shall try to increase the circulation of the Monthly Ansharullāh and motivate members to contribute their articles to the monthly issue.





157. Qā'id Ishā'at shall publish important books and literature, as and when required and supply it to the Majālis.

### **Qā'id Ta'līmul Qur'ān**

158. Qā'id Ta'līmul Qur'ān shall motivate members to learn reading of the Holy Qur'ān with correct pronunciation and to teach it to others.
159. Qā'id Ta'līmul Qur'ān shall urge members to participate in Waqf 'Ārzī.

### **Qā'id Tarbiyat Nau Mubā'i'īn**

160. Qā'id Tarbiyat Nau Mubā'i'īn shall try to maintain a strong liaison with Nau Mubā'i'īn and try to make them an active part of the Jamā'at.
161. Qā'id Tarbiyat Nau Mubā'i'īn shall see that Nau Mubā'i'īn Ansar are enrolled as members and try that they fully become part of the Ansharullah organization.

### **Auditor**

162. The Auditor shall see that auditors are appointed at the regional and local levels and try to get the accounts audited with their help.
163. All the Qā'ideen shall present the report of their activities to the Sadr Majlis every month.
164. All the members of Majlis 'Āmila Mulk shall liaise and correspond with all the Majālis as directed by the Sadr Majlis Mulk

### **Nāzim A'lā 'Ilāqa / Zila (Nāzim of a Region / District)**

165. Nāzim A'lā 'Ilāqa / Zila shall be responsible for all the affairs of the Majālis in his Region/District. It shall be his duty to see that instructions from the centre are being carried out.
166. Nāzim A'lā 'Ilāqa / Zila shall preside over the meetings of Majlis 'Āmila of the Region/District.
167. In case of an emergency Nāzim A'lā of a Region / District is allowed to authorize expenditures on his own which will have to be presented before the Majlis 'Āmila of the Region/District in the next meeting for approval.
168. Nāzim A'lā of a Region / District has the power to reject the majority opinion of his Majlis 'Āmila without specifying reasons but will have to inform the Sadr of his decision within one week, if the Majlis 'Āmila so desires.





169. Nāzim A'lā of a Region / District has the power to suspend any office bearer in his jurisdiction but he will have to immediately report the matter to the Sadr Majlis within a period not exceeding fifteen days.
170. Nāzim A'lā of a Region / District has the power to temporarily appoint someone to officiate for him or any other subordinate office-bearer but he will have to intimate the Sadr Majlis about it immediately.
171. Nāzim A'lā of Region / District has the power to prescribe reformative measures concerning members in his jurisdiction.
172. Nāzim A'lā of a Region / District shall send the report of his activities to the Sadr Majlis every month.

### **Za'im A'lā**

173. Za'im A'lā shall be responsible for all the affairs of the Majālis in the Halqas (Sectors). It shall be his duty to see that instructions from the headquarters are being carried out.
174. Za'im A'lā shall preside over the meetings of his Majlis 'Āmila.
175. In case of an emergency Za'im A'lā is allowed to authorize necessary expenditure on his own which will have to be presented before the Majlis 'Āmila in the next meeting for approval.
176. Za'im A'lā has the power to reject the majority opinion of his Majlis 'Āmila without giving reasons but he will have to inform Sadr Majlis of his decision within one week if the Majlis 'Āmila so desires.
177. Za'im A'lā has the power to suspend any office-bearer in his jurisdiction but he will have to immediately report the matter to the Sadr Majlis within a period not exceeding fifteen days.
178. Za'im A'lā has the power to temporarily appoint someone to officiate for him or for any other subordinate office-bearer but he will have to intimate the Sadr Majlis about it immediately.
179. Za'im A'lā has the power to prescribe reformative measures concerning members in his jurisdiction.
180. Za'im A'lā shall send the report of his activities to the Sadr Majlis every month.

### **Za'im Muqām / Halqa (Place / Sector)**

181. Za'im of a Place/Sector shall be responsible for all the affairs of his Majlis. It shall be his duty to see that instructions from the headquarters are being carried out.
182. Za'im of a Place/Sector shall preside over the meetings of his Majlis 'Āmila.





183. In case of an emergency Za`īm of a Place/Sector is allowed to authorize necessary expenditure on his own which will have to be presented before the Majlis 'Āmila in the next meeting for approval.
184. Za`īm of a Place/Sector has the power to reject the majority opinion of his Majlis 'Āmila without giving reason but will have to inform Sadr Majlis of his decision within one week, if the Majlis 'Āmila so desires. In case of a Halqa/Sector the intimation shall be sent to Za`īm A'lā.
185. Za`īm of a Place/Sector has the power to suspend any office-bearer in his jurisdiction but he will have to immediately report his decision to the Sadr Majlis within a period not exceeding fifteen days. In case of Za`īm Halqa the case shall be reported to the Sadr Majlis through Za`īm A'lā.
186. Za`īm of a Place/Sector has the power to appoint a person to officiate for him or any other subordinate office-bearer in his jurisdiction but he will have to inform the Sadr Majlis about it immediately. In case of Halqa/Sector the intimation should be sent to Za`īm A'lā.
187. Za`īm of a Place/Sector has the power to prescribe reformatory measures against members in his jurisdiction.
188. Za`īm of a Place/Sector shall send the report of his activities to the Sadr Majlis every month. In case of Halqa the report shall be sent to Za`īm A'lā.

**Muntazim Tarbiyat**, in consultation with Za'im Ansharullah, should identify Ansar who are not regular in the following activities and work on them to make them regular.

- Ansar who are not offering **5 daily prayers** on a regular basis.
- Ansar who are not offering **Friday prayers** on a regular basis.
- Ansar who are not listening **Friday Sermon of Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!)** on a regular basis.

**Monthly Target** – Work on 1 Nasir per month in each of the above categories.

**Nāzim Tarbiyat** will provide full assistance to Muntazimeen in achieving these targets.

### 2. Nāzim / Muntazim Tarbiyat Responsibility towards their Respective 'Āmila Members:

Muntazim Tarbiyat and Nāzim Tarbiyat, with the help of Za'im Majlis and Nāzim A'lā respectively, must ensure that 100% 'Āmila members in majlis and region are regular in the following activities:

- Offering 5 daily prayers;
- Offering at least 1 prayer in Congregation;
- Offering Friday prayers;
- Listening all Friday Sermons of Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!)
- Recitation of Holy Qur'ān with translation regularly.

### 3. Awareness of MACMIS

All Nazmeen Tarbiyat and Muntazmeen Tarbiyat should know

- How to log in the system.
- How to check all Tarbiyat Data.
- How to download required data.
- How to submit monthly report.

**Deadline:** January - February 2024

### 4. Develop personal Relationship with all Ansar

To achieve Tarbiyat targets, It is very important to development personal relationship with all Ansar brothers. For this purpose, Muntazim Tarbiyat with the help of Za'im Majlis need to visit all Ansar brothers 3-4 times in a year just for their wellbeing.

First Visit should be made before Ramadan between (1-10 March 2024) with a small gift like dates packet, Ramadan Timing chart, Ramadan spiritual program.

5. **Wasiyyat**

According to Hazoor(aa) instructions, all 'Āmila members should be Mūṣī.

And at least 50% Ansar are Mūṣī.

To achieve this target, at First stage Muntazim Tarbiyat with the help of Za'im Majlis reach all non Mūṣī 'Āmila members will Book "Al Wasiyat" and motivate them to join this bless scheme.

3. **Bai'at targets:** As advised by the Region or Markaz.

### Regional Targets

1. **Q & A Session with Contacts:** Every month at least 1 Question & Answer Session should be arranged with non-ahmadi contacts of Majālis Dā'iān members attended by Murabbī Silsila / Jamā'at scholars.
2. Utilization of **Ansharullah Tabligh Van** in booking and using for Majālis.

## Waqf Jadīd

Respective Nāẓim A'lā and Nāẓim Waqf Jadīd to ensure that every Majlis has a Muntazim Waqf Jadīd and a monthly report is sent to Markaz from ALL their Majālis.

### **MAJLIS:**

Za'īm Majlis or Muntazim Waqf Jadīd should motivate the non-participant Ansar from the previous year to take part this year.

### **REPORTING:**

Number of non-participants from previous year should be sent to Markaz as per following format on monthly basis:

1. Number of Ansar who did not participate in Chanda Waqf Jadīd last year.
2. Number of such Ansar contacted this month.
3. Number of such Ansar participated in Chanda YTD.





## Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd

### **REGION:**

Respective Nāẓim A'lā and Nāẓim Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd to ensure that every Majlis has a Muntazim Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd and a monthly report is sent to Markaz from ALL their Majālis.

### **MAJLIS:**

Ensure 100% participation of all Ansār in this blessed scheme.

Za'īm Majlis or Muntazim should motivate the nonparticipant Ansar from the previous year to take part this year.

### **REPORTING:**

Number of non-participants from previous year should be sent to Markaz as per following format on monthly basis:

1. Number of Ansar who did not participate in Chanda Taḥrīk-i-Jadīd last year.
2. Number of such Ansar contacted this month.
3. Number of such Ansar participated in Chanda YTD.





## Tajnīd

**Both active and inactive members (Ansar) are included in Majlis Tajnīd.**

**Ansar who reside in Majlis but are Inactive cannot be removed from Majlis Tajnīd.**

Majlis should make every effort to establish contact with such Ansar and bring them back in the Nizam with the help of respective Sa'iq. If needed, Za'im Majlis, Muntazim Tarbiyat, Muntazim Māl, Murabi Silsala, Jamā'at President or Secretary Tarbiyat should be involved in contacting such Ansar.

### **DUTIES:**

#### **A. Majlis - Muntazeem Tajnīd**

- 1) Update Tajnīd of Majlis reconcile with Region/Markaz on a monthly basis.
- 2) Is encouraged to help Markaz to locate un-traceable members.
- 3) Should appoint a "Saiq" for every 10 Nasir in the Majlis.
- 4) Hold atleast one Sa'iqeen meeting in a month.

#### **B. Region - Nāzim Tajnīd**

- 1) To review and reconcile Tajnīd with Markaz on a Quarterly basis.
- 2) Is encouraged to help Markaz to locate un-traceable members.
- 3) Ensure that Sa'iqeen system is active in Region's Majālis.
- 4) Hold at least one meeting with Majālis Muntazeem Tajnīd.
- 5) Quarterly meeting with Markaz (Qā'id Tajnīd)

## **GUIDELINES TO UPDATE TAJNĪD**

### **Procedure to Update Majlis Tajnīd:**

Za'im Majlis will provide move in, move out and any other changes in members' personal information through MACMIS. Qiadat Tajnīd is responsible to update Tajnīd in the system accordingly.

**Since separate policy and procedure is in place for the following two categories (memorandum attached), these will not be processed through MACMIS.**

- a) Any Nāsir who disassociates himself from Jamā'at
- b) Any permanently disabled Nāsir





## Sa'iq System in Majlis Ansharullah Canada

### **IMPORTANCE**

Sa'iq system is the cornerstone of a Majlis' structure. A Sa'iq represents Za'im Majlis and is eyes and ears of the Za'im. He is the communication channel/ medium between Ansar members and Markaz. Role of Sa'iq is so important that Khalifa Waqt is at one end of the Nizam (system) Jamā'at and Sa'iq is at the other end and in between the whole system is working. Blessed instructions and guidance of Khalifa Waqt and other important information from Markaz are conveyed to the members of a Majlis through Sa'iqeen system.

### **OBJECTIVE OF THE SA'IQEEEN SYSTEM**

A Majlis' Tajnīd is divided into smaller groups called Hizbs. A Hizb contains maximum 10-12 Ansar members. Each Hizb has a Sa'iq who is appointed by Za'im Majlis. Za'im, with the assistance of Muntazim Tajnīd, assigns members to Sa'iq, usually on the basis of geographical location of their residences or, sometimes, on the basis of personal relationships with members.

A Sa'iq is expected to keep a close contact with Ansar members of his assigned Hizb. He should establish and maintain a personal relationship with the members of his Hizb and be part of their lives as a family member. If any Nasir is facing any problem in his life, his Sa'iq should be aware of it who should immediately inform Za'im Majlis and should resolve the problem, as far as possible, with help of Za'im Majlis, Region or Markaz, as appropriate.

### **DUTIES AND TASKS OF SA'IQ**

1. From time to time, convey the messages and events information (date, time etc.) to all members in his Hizb.
2. Inform Za'im Majlis and Muntazim Tajnīd about Ansar brothers who have moved in or moved out of his Hizb.
3. Contact every member in his Hizb to get update about their wellbeing at least once a month. In the current situation of COVID-19 pandemic, this contact should be made more often.
4. Quarterly -Remind Ansar about submission of quarterly Ta'lim Exam.
5. Monthly - Make sure that all Ansar brothers in his Hizb fill out Individual report form (formerly know as "Sa'iq form") before end of month.
6. Remind Ansar brothers for payment of their monthly chanda (donation)





## Tajnīd Policy

### **MEMORANDUM**

**From:** Qā'idat Tajnīd, Majlis Anşārullāh Canada  
**Date:** February 3, 2020  
**Subject:** **Tajnīd Policy (Revised)**

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Assalam-o-alaikum wa Rahmatullah wa Baraktohu!

This is in continuation of the previous Tajnīd Policy that has already been presented in Plan 2020 (Laiah Amal).

**These procedures will address the following two categories:**

- a) **Any Nāsir who disassociates himself from Jamā'at**
- b) **Any permanently disabled Nāsir**

**a) Procedure to flag a Nāsir (in Majlis Tajnīd) who disassociates himself from Jamā'at:**

**Step 1:** Za'im Majlis should send a written request to Nāzim A'lā, detailing the name / names and stance of the individual / individuals who disassociate himself / themselves from Jamā'at.

**Step 2:** Nāzim A'lā Region should send a written request to Sadr Majlis Anşārullāh, along with his comments and recommendations, so that a flag can be put against the name of such Nāsir, in Majlis Tajnīd.

**Actions for Qā'idat Tajnīd:** After approval from Sadr Majlis, Qā'id Tajnīd should establish and maintain a list of such members in respective Majālis and put a hidden flag against those names, so that they do not affect a Majlis' overall performance / evaluation for activities like Ta'līm paper, Sa'iq form and Ijtimā' attendance.

**b) Procedure to flag a Nāsir (in Majlis Tajnīd) who is Permanently Disabled:**

**Step 1:** Za'im Majlis should send a written request to Nāzim A'lā, detailing the name and health condition of the individual who is being considered as Permanently Disabled\*.

**Step 2:** Nāzim A'lā Region should send a written request to Sadr Majlis Anşārullāh, along with his comments and recommendations, so that a flag can be put against the name of such Nāsir, in Majlis Tajnīd.

**Actions for Qā'idat Tajnīd:** After approval from Sadr Majlis, Qā'id Tajnīd should establish and maintain a list of such members in respective Majālis and put a hidden flag against those names, so that they do not affect a Majlis' overall performance / evaluation for activities like Ta'līm paper, Sa'iq form and Ijtimā' attendance.

**\*Permanently Disable:** A Nāsir who is physically or mentally unable to, directly or indirectly, perform any activity of Majlis Anşārullāh like Ta'līm paper, Sa'iq form, Ijtimā' attendance etc.

2. All office bearers of majlis shall receive a printed copy of the magazine. They should read it thoroughly and also provide their suggestions for any improvements.

4. Alhamdulillah Nahnu Anşārullāh online editions are now available at <https://www.nahnuansarullah.ca/>. The next step is to explore the possibilities of starting digital issues.
5. Reach out to members and increase contribution of articles for publication. Every majlis should contribute a minimum of four articles for publication in “Nahnu Anşārullāh”.
6. Majālis and Regions should prepare and send their events’ reports with selected pictures for publication in the magazine. The reports should be sent only by email to [ishaat@ansar.ca](mailto:ishaat@ansar.ca). Pictures should be in high resolution.
7. A competition for articles writing shall be held during the year.

8. A book titled “Salat and its Etiquettes” will be published and made available to Anşārullāh during the year.
9. Coordinate with **Ta’līm (Education)** and other Departments to prepare and publish their plan / syllabus.

2. Educate Nau Mubāyi'īn about learning Salāt, Holy Qur'ān, reading Ahadīth and the books of Promised Messiah (as), as applicable
3. Educate Nau Mubāyi'īn about Jamā'at financial system, how to fill Monthly Individual Report Form, submit Ta'līm Exams and participate in other Anşārullāh activities.
4. Educate Nau Mubāyi'īn about the 2<sup>nd</sup> Condition of Bai'at.
5. Establish Brotherhood (Muakhat) with Nau Mubāyi'īn as per instruction of Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!). Also teach them the Islamic Etiquettes.
6. Train Nau Mubāyi'īn on how to do Tablīgh in their families and friends.
7. Train Nau Mubāyi'īn on how to write letters to Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!) on a regular basis to make a personal contact with him.
8. Train Nau Mubāyi'īn on how to recite Surat Alfatihah and teach them the translation as per Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!) instructions.





# Approved Shūrā Proposals for the last 3 Years



## Majlis Shūrā 2021 Proposals and Recommendations

### **Proposal No. 2**

#### **Regularity of Office Bearers of Majlis Anṣārullāh in Observing Five Daily Prayers**

(Qīadat Tarbiyat, National Majlis 'Āmila Anṣārullāh Canada)

Syedna Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!), in his meeting with National Majlis 'Āmila Ansārullah Canada on Saturday, November 6, 2021, emphasized on the importance of five daily prayers and said:

"If the 'Āmila is not offering their Namaz, who else will offer it then? Without prayer, there can be no blessings in any task. If they believe that due to their ability, their knowledge or their hard work, their work will be blessed, then this cannot happen until it is accompanied with prayer."

Huzoor Anwar (aa) further said:

"Everyone should offer their Salāt 100% of the time. A normal Muslim should be 100% regular in his Salāt, let alone 'Āmila members who say that they have offered a particular percentage of their Salāt and then think that positive results have come forth. This is not a positive result."

In the light of Huzoor Anwar (aa) instructions, Majlis Shūrā is requested to suggest means and ways to make all Ansār brothers and especially all office bearers of Majlis Ansārullah Canada regular in observing five daily prayers.

سیدنا حضرت خلیفۃ المسیح الخامس ایدہ اللہ تعالیٰ بنصرہ العزیز نے نیشنل مجلس عاملہ انصار اللہ سے مورخہ 6 نومبر 2021ء کو اپنی ملاقات میں پنجوقتہ نمازوں کی اہمیت پر زور دیتے ہوئے ارشاد فرمایا:

"اگر عاملہ نماز نہیں ادا کر رہی ہے تو پھر کون کرے گا۔ دعا کے بغیر تو کام میں برکت نہیں پڑ سکتی۔ اگر ان کا خیال ہے کہ ان کی اپنی لیاقت کی وجہ سے، ان کے اپنے علم کی وجہ سے، ان کے اپنی محنت کی وجہ سے کام میں کوئی برکت پڑ جائے گی تو وہ نہیں پڑ سکتی جب تک دعا ساتھ نہ ہو۔"

حضور ایدہ اللہ تعالیٰ نے مزید ارشاد فرمایا:

"نماز تو 100% ہونی چاہئے۔ ایک عام مسلمان کو بھی 100% نماز پڑھنے والا ہونا چاہئے کجا یہ کہ عاملہ کے ممبران کہہ دیں کہ ہم نے اتنی فیصد پڑھی تو بڑا اچھا زلٹ ہو گیا۔ یہ تو کوئی اچھا زلٹ نہیں ہے۔"



حضور انور ایدہ اللہ تعالیٰ کی ہدایات کی روشنی میں مجلس شوریٰ سے درخواست ہے کہ ایسے ذرائع اور طریقے تجویز کریں جن سے تمام انصار بھائیوں اور خصوصاً اراکین مجلس عاملہ انصار اللہ کینیڈا کو پختہ نماز کا پابند بنایا جاسکے۔

### Proposal No. 2 – Tarbiyat Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee and approved by Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!):

1. To inculcate the importance of Salāt, National Markaz should create a brief booklet as well as audio clips based on the Holy Qur’ān, Hadīth and Khulafā’ sayings in Urdu, English and French during the first quarter.
2. National Markaz should modify the Majlis monthly report form to include personal Salāt question for Muntazmeen in all departments.
3. Regional Nāzim A’lā or Za’īm should check the situation of daily prayers before sending out the name of an ‘Āmila member for approval. They should only send names of those members who are regular in prayers. If any existing ‘Āmila member is not regular in prayers, we should pray for them for 40 days and remind and motivate them. If all efforts are exhausted, then look for a replacement.
4. Individual Monthly Report form (Sa’iq Form) should include clarification to make the question about the number of Salāt offered more clear by including that if someone combines prayers (Zuhr and Asr or Maghrib and Isha) due to some reason, he can select 5 prayers. Also mention the 3<sup>rd</sup> condition of Bait before this question. Automated reminders with motivational video clips should be sent if prayers are less than 5.
5. At Majlis level, system of Sa’iqeen should be implemented and improved to develop personal relationship with Hizb Ansār and get monthly Individual Report Form filled. Za’īm and Muntazim Tarbiyat must analyze the Salāt data and identify who is not offering 5 daily prayers. Choose appropriate ways and means to motivate identified Ansār brothers to offer 5 daily prayers with more focus in Ashra Salāt. Take attendance of office bearers during Ashra Salāt by focusing on them.
6. At majlis level, if needed, establish more Namaz Centers. Also, Ansār brothers should be reminded to motivate their family members to offer 5 daily prayers. If some Ansār members do not have a ride available to go to Namaz Center, ride should be arranged for them. Furthermore, Ansār brothers who do not know how to offer Salāt should be identified and educated.
7. In monthly meetings, the first agenda item should be review of the situation of Prayers. Also hold one Salāt awareness day every month.



8. Za'im should attend Islāhi Committee meeting with Salāt data and seek help from Sadr Halqa and Secretary Tarbiyat Jamā'at. In Friday sermons, General Body Meetings (Ijlās 'Ām) and Duroos, we must choose the importance of Salāt topic frequently.

### Proposal No. 3

#### Increase Bai'at Targets for Majlis Anṣārullāh Canada

(Qīādat Tablīgh, National Majlis 'Āmila Anṣārullāh Canada)

Syedna Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!), in his meeting with National Majlis 'Āmila Anṣārullah Canada on Saturday, November 6, 2021, gave the following instructions about Tablīgh:

"Set the bai'at targets to 100 at least. When the target is high, the efforts will be increased too. You people have contacts and hold many events etc. but the number of bai'at are low. Hold seminars, give leaflets too – look at the current world conditions and find new ways in how we can expand Tablīgh."

In the light of Huzoor Anwar (aa) instructions, Majlis Shūrā is requested to suggest means and ways to achieve at least 100 bai'at targets in the next year.

حضور انور ایدہ اللہ تعالیٰ کی ہدایات کی روشنی میں مجلس شوریٰ سے درخواست ہے کہ ایسے ذرائع اور طریقے تجویز کریں جن سے اگلے سال کم از کم 100 بیعتوں کے ہدف کو حاصل کیا جاسکے۔





### Proposal No. 3 – Tablīgh Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee and approved by Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!). The recommendations have been grouped into three main categories:

#### A. Training and Development of members and Dā'ieen-e-Khasusi

1. Institutionalize National Tablīgh Department to create and provide Tablīgh resources and training based on different ethnic / religious backgrounds and provide guidelines to general membership at region and local Majālis level. This includes but not limited to:
  - a) Develop online and printed materials
  - b) Establish contacts with local educational institutions to arrange series of lectures on social issues and their Islamic solutions.
  - c) Utilize Nau Mubāyī'īns and successful Dā'ieen experience and knowledge for training and education of the Dā'iān Ilallāh.
2. Create a Tablīgh plan based on demographics of religious and ethnic beliefs.
3. Regular use of general body meetings for education and training of members for Tablīgh.

#### B. Individual Efforts of Members

1. With the coordination of the Tarbiyat Department, a self-reformation program should be initiated to lead by example in Tablīgh activities.
2. To convert a contact into a productive fruit, Dā'ieen should establish a common interest with the contact. Once a common interest is established then contact will open a door of listening and acceptance.
3. Be inclusive by participating in religious and ethnic days/events in the community. This will provide an opportunity to introduce Islam Ahmadiyyat to those groups and communities and to establish personal contacts. Example of these events include Islamic Heritage Month, Christmas, Hanukkah, Diwali etc.
4. Initiate Neighbourhood Tablīgh Project at individual member level in one's own neighborhood. This Project will include:
  - a) Development of neighbourhood contacts and personal friendship.
  - b) Collection of ethnic, religious and economic information about neighbours.
  - c) Gift exchanges and introduction of Islam Ahmadiyyat.





**C. Suggested New Avenues of Tablīgh**

1. Creation, maintenance and usage of centralized contacts database using latest technology. This will help in follow-ups and assignment of appropriate resources during the different phases of Tablīgh. It will also help in screening and decision-making with respect to the contacts.
2. Work with Isār department for various community activities.
3. Create social media platforms to discuss social challenges and Islamic responses to these challenges. This will create contacts that can provide more contacts through groups.
4. Establish a working body of National Department of Tablīgh utilizing counterparts in other countries to learn, analyze and employ successful methods in Tablīgh.
5. Develop a monitoring body consisting of selective sub-committee members to monitor the implementation of sub-committee recommendations on a regular basis once approved by Huzoor Anwar (May Allāh be his Helper!)



## Majlis Shūrā 2022 Proposals and Recommendations

### Proposal No. 1

#### Enhancing the Participation of Ansar Brothers in Jamā'at and Majlis Activities

(Atlantic Canada Region)

It has been observed that the involvement of the members of Majlis Anṣārullāh in various activities of the Jamā'at and Majlis is on decline.

Members of Majlis Shūrā are requested to suggest ways and means to revive the engagement of Ansar brothers and enhance their participation in the activities of the Jamā'at and Majlis.

تجویز: جماعت اور مجلس کی سرگرمیوں میں انصار بھائیوں کی شرکت میں اضافہ (اطلانک کینیڈا ريجن)

مشاہدہ میں آیا ہے کہ جماعت اور مجلس کی مختلف سرگرمیوں میں مجلس انصار اللہ کے ارکان کی شمولیت کم ہوتی جا رہی ہے۔

مجلس شوریٰ کے اراکین سے گزارش ہے کہ وہ انصار بھائیوں کی ایسی سرگرمیوں میں دلچسپی کو بحال رکھنے اور شرکت کو بڑھانے کے طریقے تجویز کریں۔

### Proposal No. 1 – Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee and approved by Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!):

9. The word “Events” appearing in the subject line and in the opening sentence of the proposal should be replaced with “Activities”. This change has already been made in the proposal above.
10. At Majlis level, revive relationship with Ansār brothers through existing system of Saiqeen, ‘Āmila members, Iṣlāhī Committee and one to one contact by frequently visiting Ansār brothers. Representatives from National Markaz should accompany house visits, where possible.
11. At National level, develop an integration strategy to involve Saf Dom Ansār, promoting event based physical activities such as security, setup and windup.
12. Create a sub-committee under National Anṣārullāh Tarbiyyat department that will:
  - Develop ambitious programs for Saf Awwal and Saf Dom with focus on quality
  - Redesign refresher courses that are focused on developing the skills needed by office bearers to perform their duties in an amiable manner. For example, improved communication, problem solving and motivational skills.
13. Arrange in-person group meetings with Syedna Khalīfatul Masīh (May Allāh be his Helper!).



**Proposal No. 2****Inculcating the Status of Khilāfat in our Children****(Qīadat Tarbiyat, National Majlis ‘Āmila Anşārullāh Canada)**

It is being observed that some of our youth is still struggling to understand the true status and importance of Khilāfat-e-Ahmadiyya.

As it is the responsibility of each member of Majlis Anşārullāh to make every effort to sincerely inculcate the love of Khilāfat in the hearts of their children; therefore

Members of Majlis Shūrā are requested to suggest practical strategies for parents to:

1. help their children to maintain a close connection with Khilāfat; and
2. inculcate the significance of the heavenly status of Khilāfat in their progeny.

**Proposal No. 2 – Tarbiyat Sub-Committee Report**

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee and approved by Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!):

1. Family Mulaqat with Syedna Khalīfatul Masīh (May Allāh be his Helper!) should be encouraged as frequently as possible. Families should watch all virtual Mulaqats and addresses by beloved Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper!) on MTA and create excitement in children for these programs.
2. Parents as role models should constantly remind children to pray for Khilāfat and write letters to Syedna Khalīfatul Masīh (May Allāh be his Helper!) together.





3. In order to educate parents, regular classes, Question and Answer sessions and Sohbat-e-Saliheen sessions should be held at local level to address the questions related to the institution of Khilāfat.
4. Following means are recommended to be used by parents:
  - a) Week with Huzoor (aa) Program on MTA.
  - b) Friday Sermon for Kids program on MTA.
  - c) Local classes for children.
  - d) Twitter and YouTube channels of Jamā'at
  - e) Special events at home to discuss blessings and status of Khilāfat.

### Proposal No. 3

#### Income and Expenditure Budget 2023

(Qīadat Māl, National Majlis 'Āmila Anşārullāh Canada)

#### Proposal No. 3 – Māl Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee and approved by Hazrat Khalīfatul Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper!):

1. Chanda rates were proposed to be revised as follows:
  - Increase Chanda Ijtimā' from 1.5% to 2.5% (of one month income for the whole year)
  - Increase Chanda Ishā'at from \$5 to \$10 (for the whole year).
2. To increase the membership budget, it was proposed that:
  - a) Every Nāsir should be visited, educated and motivated to pledge as per their true income.
  - b) Individual Income Budget should be reviewed by Majālis and then by Region. They should have enough time to revisit Ansār to get their Basaharah (باشرح) budget (at least 6 weeks).



## Majlis Shūrā 2023 Proposals and Recommendations

### Proposal No. 2

#### Enhancing the Importance of Timely Marriage of our Children

(Majlis Anṣārullāh, Atlantic Canada)

As leaders within their families, members of Anṣārullāh have the responsibility of guiding and educating their children about crucial life decisions, with one of the most significant being marriage. However, there appears to be a lack of sufficient emphasis on educating our children about the importance of timely marriage and its associated matters.

Members of Majlis Shūrā are requested to suggest ways and means for Anṣārullāh members to understand the importance and benefits of timely marriage of their children and instill its significance in the hearts and minds of their children thereby encouraging them to consider and embrace timely marriages.

(مجلس انصار اللہ، اٹلانٹک کینیڈا)

تجویز ۲: بچوں کی بروقت شادی کی آگاہی کو بڑھانا

اپنے خاندانوں کے رہنماؤں کی حیثیت سے، اراکین انصار اللہ پر یہ ذمہ داری عائد ہوتی ہے کہ وہ اپنے بچوں کو زندگی کے اہم فیصلوں کے بارے میں رہنمائی اور تعلیم دیں، جس میں سب سے اہم شادی ہے۔ تاہم، ایسا لگتا ہے کہ ہمارے بچوں کو بروقت شادی کی اہمیت اور اس سے وابستہ معاملات کے بارے میں تعلیم دینے پر خاطر خواہ توجہ نہیں دی جاتی ہے۔

مجلس شوریٰ کے اراکین سے درخواست ہے کہ وہ ایسے طریقے اور ذرائع تجویز کریں جس سے اراکین انصار اللہ اپنے بچوں کی بروقت شادی کی اہمیت اور فوائد کو سمجھیں اور اپنے بچوں کے دل و دماغ میں اس کی اہمیت پیدا کریں تاکہ انہیں بروقت شادی کرنے پر آمادہ کیا جاسکے۔

### Proposal No. 2 – Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee:

#### 14. Education:

Create a list of topics that can facilitate timely marriages. These should be simple topics such as: why is marriage important, what are the biological needs of children, how can both parents be on same page, letting go of materialistic demands when searching for a match, etcetera. These topics can be printed in Nahnu Anṣārullāh for easy usage and distribution to all Jamā'at members. They can also be used for conducting interactive sessions at various events. Education of children about





marriages as well as timely marriages should start at an early age as soon as health or sex education starts in schools.

**15. Data Collection and Analytics:**

Anonymous collection of data on problems affecting families pertaining to timely marriages should be conducted on regular basis. Department of Tarbiyyat and Department of 'Umūmī can work together to collect this data and analyze the results. This analysis can be used to define further actions.

**16. Process related recommendations:**

Department of Tarbiyyat will facilitate improvement of coordination between departments and auxiliaries involved with marriage in general, with special focus on timely marriage.

**Voting Results:** Majority of Shūrā Delegates voted to approve the above recommendations (266 in favor; 4 against).

Based on the majority votes as noted above, the proposal is considered as approved by Majlis Shūrā.





## Proposal No. 3

### Income and Expenditure Budget 2024

(Qiādat Māl, National Majlis ‘Āmila Anşārullāh Canada)

### Proposal No. 3 – Sub-Committee Report

Following recommendations were proposed by members of sub-committee:

1. Solid measures should be taken to enhance collection from non-paying / less paying members.
2. We should try to contact Ansar members regularly and use all resources to motivate members for Salaat and to pay Chanda as per prescribed rate.
3. Appendix F of Income Budget needs to be more informative by adding one more column for same period comparison.
4. Isār department should come up with comprehensive plan for humanitarian assistance.

**Voting Results:** Following is the result of voting after open house discussion:

- **Income Budget with recommendations noted above:** Unanimously in favor (no one voted against it).
- **Expense Budget with recommendations noted above:** Unanimously in favor (no one voted against it).

Based on the majority votes as noted above, budget is considered as approved by Majlis Shūrā.

## Sohbat-e-Saliheen Program Guidelines

(This can be considered as IJLAS-E- 'ĀM as well and accordingly report in monthly report form.)

### How to arrange sessions for each quarter

1. Up to 1.5 to 2 hours session. Preferably in Mosque or Namaz Center and if at home then simple tea with one to two items of refreshments.
2. Markaz representative will try to attend at least 1st one session of the Region. Rest of the sessions will be led by Regional representative and/or Murabbi Silsila or some other elder of Jamā'at
3. Must be Saiqeen based and Ansar participation as follows:
  - Should not be more than 2 Saiqeen Hizbs.
  - Up to 12 Ansar.
4. Once all Saiqeen finish for Majlis than arrange a session for Ansar who;
  - Had not attended any session
  - Up to 10 to 12 Ansar and 3 to 4 Saiqeen
5. Once above two rounds will finish for the Suhbate Salheen Sessions then
  - Visit and meet the remaining Ansar one by one by the Saiq & Muntazim Tarbiyat or Zai'm Majlis
  - And discuss with them individually on the same pattern of Sohbat-e-Salheen Session

### How to conduct session

#### ROUND # 1 (Introduction of Ansar)

This INTRODUCTION is not required every time when we conduct the program for a Saiq / Hizb. Only required when SESSION is conducted for the first time OR when REGIONAL or MARKAZI rep is conducting the session:

1. Silent Prayers
2. Introduction
  - a) Name and Children with their ages & what are they doing
  - b) Where they belong to before coming to Canada
  - c) When came to Canada
  - d) What are they doing professionally now?





## **ROUND # 2**

### **Option A – Sharing Faith Inspiring Incidents:**

If the HIZB already done then they MUST conduct as per OPTION B which is TOPIC BASED discussion

### **OPTION B (Topics Based; In any order with 1 topic per quarter)**

1. Obedience of Nizam Jamā'at
2. Rizq-e-Halal and Truthfulness
3. Timely Marriage
4. Drugs and Alcohol

### **How to Conduct Round 2**

1. CAUTION – Keep check avoid any **showoff** in narrating personal incidents
2. Ask who want to give comments and request them one by one
3. If time allows, then ask for second round

## **ROUND 3 (Closing Remarks)**

Summarize and motivate with one strong message for not more than 5 minutes.
